WHAT COURSES ARE TECH PREP AT MY HIGH SCHOOL?

As part of the agreement between **South Puget Sound Community College** and **Timberline High School**, credits earned in certain high school technical classes (occupational education) can also be awarded as college credit. Once you have received a “B” grade or better and met all of the requirements you will have a college transcript at the college.

Students may use these credits toward an Associate of Technical Arts Degree, as electives in an Associate of Arts Degree (Transfer Degree to 4-year University), or to enter the military at a higher rank. Students may also transfer the credits to other colleges or universities depending upon their transfer policies. Tech Prep credits may be listed on job applications. At **Timberline High School** the following courses are available for earning college credit:
