- Bring Photo ID (student ID, military, driver's license, state ID)
- Bring SPSCC Student Identification Number (SID)
- Walk In Testing- No appointment required
- Daily parking permits for testing/orientations are available in Security Office and Enrollment Services in Building 25

CPT (College Placement Test/Accuplacer)

- CPT- College Placement Test at Mottman Campus
- CPT HAWKS- College Placement Test at Hawks Prairie Campus
- Cost \$15 for entire test — \$15 per re-test (cash, card, check)
- The placement test in not a pass/ fail test. Everyone will place into a class.

Qualifying for Running Start

- Students must pass the Sentence Skills and Reading portions with individual scores of 80 or better and a combined score of at least 180 to qualify for English 101.
- Students should also take the math portion of the placement test if they plan to take any math classes at the college or a class with a math prerequisite.

GED

- Cost \$75 for entire GED — \$15 per test (cash, card, check)
- Attending a mandatory GED orientation is required before testing
- Have GED Packet completed prior to orientation
- GED Packets are available in the Testing Center and at Hawks Prairie Campus
- Photo ID is required. Acceptable photo ID is a state issued ID card, driver's license, military or VA ID, tribal ID, passport or SPSCC student ID. ASB card from High School will be accepted only with social security card, birth certificate or other official document providing identity.
- If you are 16-19 years old, you will need to bring an Approval to Test Form or Notarized Home School Letter prior to testing.
- Approval to Test forms are available at your high school or school district office.
